

# Installation of Bulk Fuel Station for Darwin utility company

The Power & Water Authority in Darwin Australia required a new bulk diesel station to run a large generator set that supplies 3 phase power to run water pumps used to maintain water supply in suburban areas of Darwin.

OEG's scope of work included the installation and commissioning of a 10,000 Litre self bunded diesel storage tank as well as an 800 Litre Day tank. The Day tank was fabricated by OEG Darwin and installed and piped at the site.

An EBS Ray transfer pump was also required. This draws fuel from the 10,000 Litre bulk tank and tops up the 800 Litre day tank.

All supply and return 316L stainless steel pipework on site was fabricated & installed by OEG Darwin as well as all electrical switching and controls. Sub-contracted electrician installations were also tested and commissioned by fully qualified OEG technicians.

The Darwin team has carried out several remote location fuel installations for oil and gas operators as well as a growing number for the civil sector in Australia.
